Action Clerk to advise Russell Harley to paint white/illuminous yellow lines in village hall car park. To put onto next Full Parish Council meeting to discuss lighting.


7.2 It was noted that the bridge to Willoughby Close, including the railings has overgrown with stinging nettles and thistles and needs cutting back.
